

## Wording of your Will

Should you choose to remember Velindre Cancer Centre in your Will, it may be helpful to use the following wording when dealing with your Solicitor. This will guarantee that your wishes are followed accurately. Please use the following wording, just as it is written below.

### For a Residuary bequest – a proportion, please use the following:

I give (all or share) of the residue of my estate which I can dispose of by Will in any manner I think proper to Velindre Cancer Centre – registered charity number 1052501 of Velindre Fundraising, Velindre Cancer Centre, Whitchurch, Cardiff CF14 2TL, and the receipt of the Honorary Treasurer or the proper officer for the time being of Velindre Cancer Centre shall be a complete discharge to my Executors.

### For a Pecuniary bequest – a set sum, please use the following:

I give the sum of ..... pounds to Velindre Cancer Centre – registered charity number 1052501 of Velindre Fundraising, Velindre Cancer Centre, Whitchurch, Cardiff CF14 2TL, and the receipt of the Honorary Treasurer or other proper officer for the time being of Velindre Cancer Centre shall be a complete discharge to my Executors.

### Whichever wording you choose to use, it is also important to insert the following clause:

If at my death any charity named as a beneficiary in this Will or any Codicil hereto has changed its name or amalgamated with or transferred its assets to another body then my Executors shall give effect to any gift made to such charity as if it had been made (in the first case) to the body in its changed name or (in the second place) to the body which results from such amalgamation or to which such transfer has been made.
